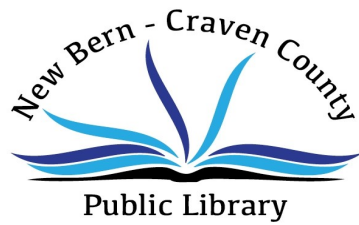

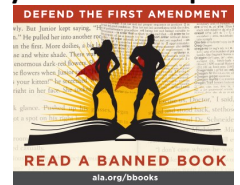

Tech Tutor* ~ Sign-up for a one-on-one tech session with a staff member. Ask at the Reference Desk for available days and times.

Sept. 6: iPhone Basics* ~ 2:30-4:00 p.m. ~ Learn how to use your iPhone (any generation), including: contacts, apps, phone, and eBooks. No computer skills necessary, but an iPhone is required.

Sept. 11: Kindle Fire Basics* ~ 2:30-4:00 p.m. ~ This class will cover the basics of the Kindle Fire tablet—basic functions, apps, and eBooks. No computer skills necessary, but a Kindle Fire (any version) or Fire Phone is required.

Sept. 12 & 14: Beginning Internet* ~ 10:00-11:30 a.m. ~ This is a 2-day class. The class is designed for new computer users to introduce the mouse and keyboard, Internet searching, email, printing, and the library's online catalog. No computer skills required.

Sept. 12: World of eBooks* ~ 6:30-8:00 p.m. ~ Learn how to download the library's eBooks from our new vendor OverDrive to your smartphones, tablets, or eReaders – even Kindles! Computer experience is not required. Students may bring their devices for questions and answers.
